The motto of Pope St. Pius X and of our parish is "to restore all things in Christ". We strive to do just that through liturgy, community life, and love of neighbor.





<u>ACTS Retreats</u> are weekend retreats presented by parishioners built around Adoration, Community, Theology, and Service. Retreats are held for men, women, and teens.

**The Order of Alhambra** is a group of men that through their social and fraternal work enhance the quality of life for the intellectually disabled and memorialize persons, places, and events significant to our Catholic heritage.

**St. Martin of the Fields Arboreans** are men and women dedicated to the beautification of the church grounds and the priests' house. They meet most Saturdays to mow, trim, tend plants, maintain sprinklers, and do other projects.

The Catholic Daughters of The Americas, Court Our Lady of Knock #2652 are Catholic women who donate to charities, administer scholarship programs, and strive "to be helping hands where there is pain, poverty, sorrow or sickness." They gather for a special intention rosary on the third Sunday of the month and enjoy each other's company on the fourth Wednesday of each month.

**Eucharistic Apostles of Divine Mercy** promote devotion to the Divine Mercy. They meet each Sunday in the chapel at 3:00 PM (mercy hour) and pray for the sick and dying.

**The Fellowship Committee** plans, promotes, and implements gatherings to promote friendship in our church community. Men and women are welcome. Meetings are on the second Tuesday of the month.



Our Lady of Guadalupe Society encourages devotion to Mary under the title of Our Lady of Guadalupe by cultivating members' leadership to participate in the mission of the church and developing projects that the pastor suggests. They hold an annual spiritual retreat, gather to pray the rosary on the twelfth day of the month, and meet on the second Thursday of the month.

The Knights of Columbus is a Catholic fraternal organization of men established to provide service to the Church and community, to develop a deeper understanding of our Catholic faith, and to protect our families' financial futures with insurance protection. They lead a Healing Rosary on the first Sunday of the Month. Meetings are on the fourth Thursday of the month.

The Legion of Mary is an apostolic organization of Catholic lay people whose members become instruments of the Holy Spirit through a balanced program of prayer and service.

<u>Liturgical Ministry</u> is made up of Music, Greeters, Lectors, Altar Servers, Ushers, Projector, and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist. Training for all of these is offered periodically.



Msgr. Brosnan Rosary Guild meets on the first Thursday of the month (September- May) to assemble, collect, and check cord rosaries which are then mailed throughout the country. We also supply rosaries for BAMC, the Adoration Chapel, and the Legion of Mary.

<u>Prison Ministry</u> supports our Catholic brothers in white at the John B. Connally Prison Unit in Kenedy, TX through Catholic retreats and Faithbased Life Skills classes by volunteering at the prison and by raising funds to provide materials to help these men learn and grow in their faith.

**Reflections** is a monthly gathering of women offering an opportunity to stop, breathe, and "just be" with the Lord and each other through reading and discussing books of a spiritual nature. Reflections meets at 7 PM the first Wednesday of each month.

**Religious Education Catechists** bring the Word of God to our parish children and teens. Classes take place on Sunday mornings at 9:00 AM.

<u>Small Communities of Faith</u> consist of groups of 8 to 12 adults who meet weekly to grow in faith and friendship through discussion of the Sunday Bible readings.



<u>Stephen Ministry</u> trains Stephen Ministers to provide one-on-one Christian care to people who are hurting. Ministers are ready to journey alongside others - listening, caring, encouraging, and providing emotional and spiritual support in a confidential manner.

# The Society of St. Vincent de Paul

provides assistance to the needy and suffering in our geographic area through a food pantry and other programs. Volunteers staff the food pantry on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM.

**Theology on Tap** serves the young adult and adult communities providing faith formation. Each Tuesday night presents a particular topic to learn more about our faith and have faith-filled discussions.

<u>Vocation Committee</u> assists the parish in fulfilling its mission of fostering vocations, reminding parish members to respond to God's call in their lives, especially to ordained ministry and consecrated life. The group shepherds the parish initiatives of prayer, promotion, mentoring, and invitation to help increase vocational awareness.

**Young Adult Ministry** is for adults ages 18 to 35. This ministry is here to help build up faith and offer unique opportunities for faith formation. They meet on Tuesday evenings at 7:00 PM.



Women of St Pius X (WSPX) is an organization of Catholic women who support our church and are dedicated to promoting a sense of fellowship, spirituality, and cooperation within our parish community and the other organizations therein. Meetings are on the first Thursday of the month, (August – June).
